Sustainability Policy – In-House Events

Badminton Estate is committed to hosting events in a way that respects and protects the historic landscape and natural environment of the estate. This policy applies specifically to all in-house events, including Open Garden Days, corporate events, and private hire. It does not extend to wider estate operations, farming, residential properties, or third-party activities beyond the event footprint.

Our aim is to minimise environmental impact wherever reasonably possible while maintaining the high-quality experience expected by our visitors, clients, and guests. We work with our team, suppliers, and event organisers to encourage responsible practices that support the long-term care of the estate and its surroundings.

Environmental Consideration

- Events are planned with consideration for the surrounding landscape, gardens, and wildlife habitats.
- Temporary structures, installations, and infrastructure are positioned to minimise disturbance to the natural environment wherever possible.
- Event layouts are designed to protect sensitive areas of the grounds and maintain the integrity of historic landscapes.

Waste & Recycling

- Waste reduction is encouraged across all events through careful planning and supplier coordination.
- Recycling facilities are provided where possible, and guests are encouraged to dispose of waste responsibly.
- Event organisers and suppliers are encouraged to minimise single-use materials and reduce unnecessary packaging.

Suppliers & Materials

- Where feasible, we encourage the use of local suppliers and responsibly sourced materials.
- Event partners are asked to consider sustainable options when selecting décor, materials, and event infrastructure.
- Reusable or recyclable materials are preferred wherever practical.

Energy & Resources

- Energy use is managed carefully during events, with temporary power and lighting used only where necessary.
- Water use is monitored in event areas, and suppliers are encouraged to minimise unnecessary consumption.
- Where possible, efficient equipment and lighting solutions are used to reduce energy demand.

Protecting the Estate

- As a historic estate with landscaped parkland, certain areas may require additional care or protection during events.
- Guests and suppliers are asked to respect gardens, planting, trees, and wildlife habitats.
- Event staff and stewards are present to guide visitors and help ensure the grounds are enjoyed responsibly.

Working With Clients & Suppliers

- Clients planning corporate events or private hire are encouraged to consider sustainability when designing their event.
- The estate team works collaboratively with organisers and suppliers to support responsible event planning wherever possible.
- Reasonable steps may be taken to minimise environmental impact while maintaining the practical requirements of each event.
